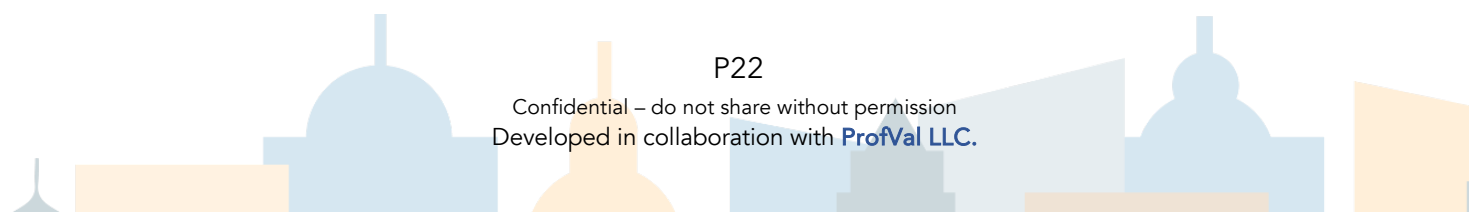
Figure 5: Concentration Overview

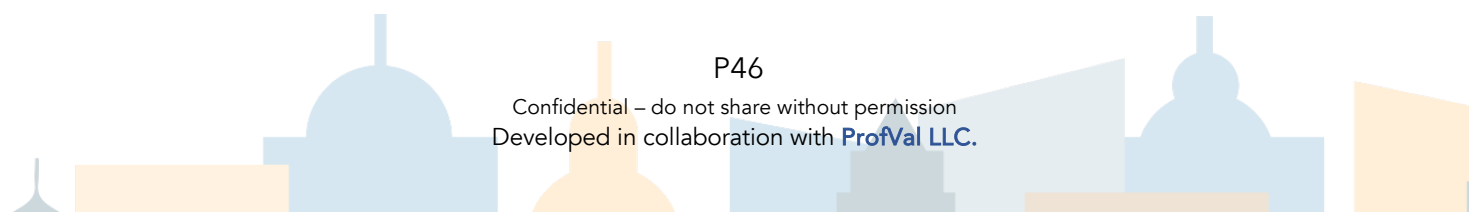

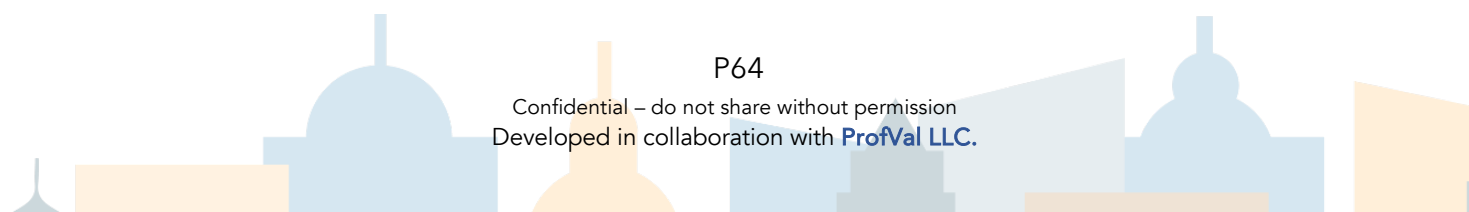
